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#### **PAKISTAN - A LAND OF OPPORTUNITIES**


#### A QUICK GLANCE: PAKISTAN ECONOMY & LOGISTICS SECTOR

Pakistan is strategically located in the crossroads of Asia with China as its neighbour in the north, India in the east and Afghanistan in the west. Thus, its strategic location allows Pakistan to become an important trade, energy and transport corridor.

Pakistan is the gateway to energy rich States of Central Asia, the Gulf States and far Eastern countries. This unique feature of Pakistan's strategic location makes it a place of endless possibilities.

According to Pakistan Economic Survey 2018-2019 analyzed by Gallup Pakistan, in 2018-2019, Pakistan's largest export industry was the textile industry, with hosiery and readymade garments contributing PKR 544 billion to total trade.

The Freight Forwarding and Logistics industry plays a Readymade vital role in the overall economy of Pakistan and covers garments - 259 air freight, sea freight, custom clearance, warehousing, road & rail transportation, packing and other value added services. For goods producing countries like Hosiery - 285 Pakistan, strong logistics is an essential component of the supply chain and is a key driver for private-sector development and overall economic growth.

China is working on creating a network of railways, roads, pipelines, and utility grids that would link China and Central Asia, West Asia, and parts of South Asia.

This initiative, "Belt and Road" comprises more than physical connections. Pakistan and China have successfully launched 22 projects on the ground, costing more than US\$ 28.5 billion. The government is expanding the scope of CPEC so that it becomes a "Gateway of Prosperity" for both countries and the region at large.



Pakistan and Russia have signed their largest-ever deal worth billions of dollars for expanding trade and business ties. The deal includes huge investments in energy, rail and steel industries. Moscow will also help to construct a railway track from Quetta to Taftan.

Pakistan, Egypt agree to promote trade

During JWG meeting, it was agreed to enhance trade in key sectors inlcuding agriculture, construction, textiles, leather, chemicals etc. Confernce was held followed by signing MOU.

#### Green Corridor to boost agricultural trade between China, Pakistan

With the simplified clearance procedures and future improvement of transportation facilities, more agricultural products are expected to be imported from Pakistan. As China becomes the biggest importer of agricultural products in the world, the rising demand will boost the agricultural sector in Pakistan. China and Pakistan have agreed to launch a "Green Corridor" system that will fast-track two-way customs clearance exclusively for agricultural products, according to a statement from China's Ministry of Commerce.

#### Investment Opportunities at Karachi Port Pakistan

Thailand Board of Investment (BOI)'s delegation visited KPT Head Office. They took keen interest in port projects as KPT has the potential to become regional Hub for trade particularly for transit and transhipment.

#### Indonesian envoy for enhancing bilateral ties in trade

Indonesian Ambassador to Pakistan said that trade ties between Indonesia and Pakistan will be further strengthened. He said that palm oil production was important to economy of Indonesia as the country was one of the biggest exporters.
