

December 2023:

Pakistan's exports to the Gulf region witnessed a significant increase of 26.6 percent in the first five months of the current fiscal year, according to the central bank data released this month, with 50 percent rise in its trade with Saudi Arabia and 33 percent with the United Arab Emirates.

The country established the Special Investment Facilitation Council (SIFC) – a civil-military hybrid forum – in July to fast-track decision-making and promote investment from foreign nations, particularly from the Gulf countries.

Pakistan also announced in September it had signed a "preliminary" free trade agreement with the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) and described it as a "milestone in both sides' economic cooperation." The quantum of Pakistan's trade with the UAE also increased significantly from \$614.9 million to \$818 million during these months

The development works will include deepening of berths, achieving deep draft of 14.5m and similarly, AD Ports Group is working to develop a new turning basin to handle 355m LOA vessels.

This will create wider array of opportunities for the shipping industry. Through these initiatives and investments, AD Ports Group is postively impacting Karachi Port's terminal infrastructure making it a key logistical hub for trade and strengthening bilateral ties between the UAE and Pakistan, thereby facilitate the Blue Economy of Pakistan.
